He was born April 4th, 1895, in San Jose, Calif, and eleven years later experienced the 1906 earthquake in that city.

By 1909 entrenched in the city of San Francisco, became a wireless amateur with call letters "D Q" and later "6MA".

Received commercial Radio operators license 1913, and assigned to the S.S. Oleum with United Wireless equipment, his first ship.

WTD

During the years from 1913 to 1916 he was at the Marconi Shop, and later on such ships as the S.S. Santa Rita, S.S. Yosemite, S.S. Francis H. Hanify, and the S.S. Alliance, resigning from the Marconi Company April 14th, 1916.

The period of World War I, was spent aboard the USS Cuyama as electrical and Engineering Officer with rank of Lieut (jg).

From 1921 to 1925 he was a radio salesman for the Leo J. Meyberg Co, Instructor at the Radio Institute of America, Service Manager for Radiola radios manufactured by RCA.

In later years until retirement he was in business for himself (Radio & Electrical Appliances), Electrical Inspector for new ship construction for the War Shipping Administration, Marine Surveyor for the United States Maritime Administration, and an Associate Member of M.J. GIGY & ASSOCIATES INC, sales Engineers of Marine equipment, retiring from there December 31st, 1963.

A member of the Propeller Club of America, The Society of Port Engineers, The Mariners Club, and the Marine Square Club of San Francisco. Member of Paul Revere Lodge No. 462 F.&A.M.
