

Returned to merchant marine operating in 1931 for period of three years serving on various vessels, both freight and passenger in the Alaskan and West Coast service, including:

Left commercial operating field in 1935 to enter radio/electronics installation for U. S. Government (CAA/FAA and FWLS) from which retired in 1958. Subsequent activity as professional free-lance writer of numerous national magazine feature articles and seven published books on electronic subjects.

Also served as week-end relief operator on coastal marine shore station KFT at Everett, Wash. for about a year (1935/36).

HOWARD S. PYLE: A ham since 1908 but first commercially licensed in April, 1917 and assigned SS RUSH for SORS. Wrecked Herendeen Bay, Alaska May 1917. Re-assigned SS SPOKANE serving until enlisted US Navy July 1917 for WW-1. Naval operating service at NPD, NEQD, NVD, NVH, NPC, NPZ until discharged Dec. 1921 as CRM(PA). Made one trip West Indies for IWT on SS LAKE WINTHROP then appointed Asst. US Radio Inspector, 8th Radio District, in 1922. Resigned 1923 to enter RCA service as operator SS GREATER DETROIT, GREATER BUFFALO, CITY OF CLEVELAND III, CITY OF DETROIT III then assigned to Chicago Coastal marine station WGO, resigning as Manager in 1926 to return West Coast where returned to marine duty. Served on all Alexander ships of Pac. Coast SS Co., H.F., RUTH, DOROTHY, EMMA etc. then transferred to Alaska SS Co., aboard SS CORDOVA, DENALI, VICTORIA and others until 1934. Left marine service to enter US Civil Service as Radio Installation Electrician for Civil Aeronautics Authority (now Federal Airways Administration) remaining until failing health in 1956 prohibited further travel duty as Supervisory Electronics Installation Engineer and forced transfer to Fish and Wildlife Service in Electronic Engineering capacity. In 1957 continued health problems forced disability retirement. Since retiring, remain at home writing feature articles for national electronics magazines and have produced nine books on electronic subjects. Club affiliations include; Sr. Member, IEEE, former Vice-Director ARRL; OOTC; Wireless Pioneers; OTC; QCWA; ARNS; QRP/ARC-I and NWC. Still writing for publication using ham radio (W70E) as relaxation hobby.
