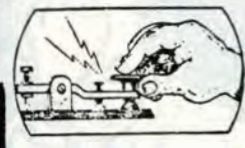

Dear Mr Boyd,

I am sorry I havenot yet paid my dues for 1997, I am sure you will forgive me when I give you my reason. My husband, Ray and I arrived back in the States from England in mid October but unfortunately we had to leave again for the U.K. at the end of November as Ray was diagnosed with Advanced Terminal Cancer of the colon, liver, lungs and lymph glands. He died five weeks later on the 5th January. I returned on the 24th February and have had a great deal to sort out - thank you letters all sorts of odd jobs in the home and some new work to make me feel more secure. I suddenly thought I had missed my subs and also I wanted to write to let you know about the passing of one of the SOWP members. I enclose my check no. 748 in the amount of \$ 15.00 - I hope that when I return this October I will not forget my 1998 dues.

My very sad news is that N2DAN Steve Nurkiewicz passed away on the 20th May this year. Steve had been having radiation treatment since January for a small lump on the outside of his right lung, this was removed, but proved to be much larger than the 3 cms - more like a small orange. Afterwards on the Monday 5th May he was pronounced to be completely cancer free throughout his body. On the 7th he started to have a high temperature and was turning yellow, so Friday the 9th he went back into hospital and after a series of tests they found he had terminal cancer of the liver. He returned home on the 13th May and died just a week later on the 20th. In that week he went down very fast and I am glad to say apart from some pain he suffered very little just like Ray, very little pain and rapid deterioration. For me it is very sad not only to loose my dear one but to also loose my very good friend. Steve's wife, Terry, is still in a state of shock but is holding her own very well and being very brave. I am sure Ted Phelps W8TP will be very sorry to hear the news about Steve as we often had a 3 way QSO with Ted and Ted has one of Steve's beautiful "Mercury" Keyers now unfortunately no more. Steve's SOWP nr. was 4209V. I am sorry to be the importer of such bad news.

I missed the usual enjoyable Xmas party - hope to take part this year.


